1. Organizing Authority
 - 1.1. Fleet 29 Sanford Florida
 - 1.2. And the Yacht Clubs or Sailing Association of following Events and Locations:
 - 1.2.1. EVENT 1: Trans Monroe & Southern Challenge – Lake Monroe Sailing Association – March 7th & 8th 2026
 - 1.2.2. EVENT 2: 73rd Mt. Dora Annual Sailing Regatta – Mount Dora Yacht Club – March 21st & 22nd 2026
 - 1.2.3. EVENT 3: Lake Weir Invitational – Ocala Sailing Club – April 11th 2026
 - 1.2.4. EVENT 4: Lake Weir – Ocala Sailing Club – October 2026 TBD
 - 1.2.5. EVENT 4: Sanford Sailfest Regatta – Lake Monroe Sailing Association - December 2026
2. Rules
 - 2.1. The Series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
 - 2.2. The San Juan 21 Class Associations Rules will apply
 - 2.3. In case of a protest the representative from each boat that attends the protest in the protest room shall be the owner/helmsman.
 - 2.4. Further details will be communicated through each of the events Sailing Instructions.
3. Advertising

- 3.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
4. Eligibility and Entry
 - 4.1. The series is open to all boats of Fleet 29 San Juan 21.
 - 4.2. All boats/owners must follow Class Rules.
 - 4.3. Notification to the Fleet 29 travel series should be submitted to Fleet 29 by e-mail bohawn@gmail.com
 - 4.4. Registration to each event must be completed at the race office of the organizing yacht club or association.
5. Entry Fee
 - 5.1. Entry Fee will be posted by each of the Events Organizing Authority.
6. Regatta Schedule
 - 6.1. The regatta schedule will be posted by each of the Events Organizing Authority.
 - 6.2. Social Events will be posted by the Events Organizing Authority.
 - 6.3. It is appreciated if all sailors of Fleet 29 are present at the awards of each Regatta Event.
 - 6.4. It is recommended but not necessary for every member to attempt to attend the San Juan 21 Nationals.
7. Measurements and Weights
 - 7.1. All competitors should observe class Measurement rules. There might be measurements check both before the regatta start and during the event.
 - 7.2. Rules can be found in the San Juan 21 Class Association Handbook.
8. Sailing Instructions

8.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available upon registration at the Race Office of each Yacht Club or Association.

9. Scoring

9.1. The Low Point System in Appendix "A" of the racing rules will be used. Rule A9 will apply.

9.2. One Regatta is needed to be competed to constitute the Fleet 29 Travel Series of 2020.

9.3. When Five regattas have been completed, the boats worst regatta score will be discarded.

9.4. Owners may pick a team to participate in races.

10. Prizes

10.1. The Organizing Authority of each event will outline individual awards in the events sailing instructions.

10.2. Fleet 29 will award the Fleet 29 Travel Series Trophy at the end of the season.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

11.1. Competitors participate in the regattas entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
